### Curriculum Impact

#### **This is what you might typically see:**

- Happy and engaged learners
- A variety of independent, paired and group work
- Exploratory work, practise and high-quality final pieces
- Engagement and perseverance
- Self-motivated children
- Children talking positively about the curriculum, sharing and reflecting on their learning
- Children remembering prior learning so they have strong foundations for new learning
- Progress in written work over time

#### **This is how we know how well our pupils are doing:**

- Observations of work being produced, books.
- Verbal feedback from teacher to pupil
- Verbal feedback from pupil to teacher/TA
- Pupil voice conversations with Subject Leaders/ SLT
- Photo/video evidence on Seesaw
- Monitoring of children's progress over time
- Assessments (low stakes quizzes, termly tests, statutory tests)

#### **This is the impact of the Curriculum:**

- Confident children who can talk about their learning in different subject areas.
- Children who are enjoying their learning.
- Children who want to know more.
- Children who are equipped with a range of knowledge, skills and techniques to enable them to become lifelong learners
- Children with an understanding of a diverse range of traditions, times and cultures across a variety of different subjects
- Children know what they can do to improve.
